Integris Baptist Medical Center *Oklahoma City, OK*



Opened Easter Sunday 1959 as a 200-bed hospital, INTEGRIS Baptist Medical Center has grown to a 508-bed facility offering comprehensive health-care programs and services.

INTEGRIS Baptist Medical Center offers a full range of diagnostic, therapeutic and rehabilitative services. Special services provided include respiratory therapy, rehabilitative services including physical, occupational, speech therapy and cardiac rehabilitation; pulmonary laboratory, ECG and EEG services; radiology services including magnetic resonance imaging (MRI), CT scan, biplane angiography, digital subtraction angiography, both general and cardiac ultrasounds; Nuclear Medicine and radiation therapy; and Oklahoma's most comprehensive hyperbaric medicine and wound care center.

Integris Bass Baptist Health Center *Oklahoma City, OK*

The INTEGRIS Bass Baptist Health Center campus includes 207 licensed beds throughout three facilities. The hospital enjoys the distinctions of being the only non-profit, faith-based hospital in Enid and having served the Enid area longer than any other general hospital. INTEGRIS Bass Baptist Health Center offers acute care and diagnostic services, skilled nursing, a cancer center, a state of the art Heart Center, a cardiac catheterization laboratory, cardiovascular and thoracic surgery, geriatric behavioral health services, OB/GYN services, home health services and occupational health services.

In 2003, the hospital completed an 8.2 million dollar expansion project that tripled the size of the Emergency Department and included a new Womens Center.

Integris Canadian Valley Regional Hospital *Yukon, OK*

Canadian Valley Regional Hospital opened as a general acute care facility on November 9, 2001. The facility consists of approximately 128,000 square feet and includes 44 inpatient beds as well as a medical office building. The hospital has 30 private medical surgical rooms, a 10-bed Women's Unit and a newly constructed 4-bed Intensive Care Unit. The surgical department of the hospital includes a dedicated c-section operating room and three general surgical rooms as well as an endoscopy area and an 8-bed outpatient procedure unit. Services also include a level four Emergency Department; Radiology services consisting of mammography, radiological, fluoroscopy, cat scan, ultrasound, bone density, nuclear medicine, and a mobile MRI. General laboratory services are available along with cardiopulmonary capabilities and a physical medicine department that includes aquatic therapy services.

Formerly known as South Community Hospital, Integris Southwest Medical Center has grown from a 73-bed community hospital to a comprehensive medical center offering a full range of medical, support and rehabilitation services with 369 beds.
